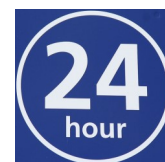

# Prayer Walks



## **Saturday 12th May—Beech - 3pm**

Meeting at the Village Hall car park at 3pm, pray for the life of the village and the Hall as a focus for village life. Walking left up Well House Road pause outside St Peter's praying for the church in the community, and for the life of Alton Abbey. Continue up Well House stopping where appropriate to pray for the residents of Beech. Pray for a closer relationship of villagers. Give thanks for the beauty of the landscape surrounding the village

**Tuesday 15th May—Mettle Town Walk 7.00pm—meet at St Lawrence Church. Walk with our young people as they pray for our town.**

## **Wednesday 16th May—Gift of Years Walk—11am**

Join us at 11am outside Fielder's Court for a prayer walk taking in some of our residential and Nursing Homes: Brendoncare & Mary Rose Mews, Orchard House, Willow & Cloverleaf Courts, finishing at Borovere at approximately 12.30. This is a chance to give thanks and pray for older people in our parish and remember our Anna Chaplains and all who support or care for older people and their families.

## **Friday 18th May—Alton North— 2pm**

Meet together by Raven Square. Pray for the businesses on The Parade before heading East along Wootey's Way. Pray for the people living in this area before crossing Anstey Lane into Jenner Way. Walking South along Jenner Way stop to pray for the residents here before turning left back on to Anstey Lane. Pause by the playing fields and pray for the recreation of our parish and how we might reach out to the players and walkers with the Gospel. At the Vets Surgery pray for those who rely on their pets for their only company.

Turn right onto Anstey Road, right into Nursery Road, left into Victoria Road finishing at St Lawrence Church, praying for the local residents along the route.

## **Saturday 19th May—Holybourne—2pm**

Starting at Holybourne Theatre, we pray for the people who participate in the artistic life of the community. At Andrew's Endowed School, we pray for the pupils and staff at both this school and at Treloars.. We proceed up Howards Lane, stopping at the church to give thanks for the Living Space Project . Walking down Church Lane,, we stop in the centre, to pray for the residents of The Lawn and the business community of Holybourne at the Village Shop and The White Hart. A little further on, we pray for the residents of the village by the play park and for the members of Holybourne Cricket Club. Doubling back , the walk ends at The Lawn where we pray for the elderly members of the community.
